SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT

In the context of today's globalization, the definition of physical and imaginary boundaries allows us to understand the complex logic of inclusion and/or exclusion and discrimination. Accordingly, and approaching the growing migratory flow that people carry out between countries and/or continents, individuals must not only face geopolitical borders that make the difference between individuals belonging to a nation and foreigners (or which differentiates between autochthonous vs. immigrant), but they also must face internal boundaries: ethnic, cultural, class, social, gender, language, thinking, etc.

These internal borders, which vary according to the social context of the community in the country where we are, accentuate the difference between the "you" and the "I". This difference, referring to the feeling of belonging to a nation or to the identification of the subject with the various internal borders, is exclusive of the "us" that embraces the community by the mere fact of existing as such, with entrances and exits of people that are part of, as an example of a great organism that inspires and expires to live.

But like everything, borders mutate. They have done it with the passage of time: they have grown, they have diminished, they have multiplied and they have become those that today establish the limits of the society in which we live and those that constitute the growing process of globalization, which paradoxically makes the free movement of goods and capital possible but it does not apply in the same way for people.

What if among we all manage to make these borders mutate again and transform them into something closer to the initial "we", with which embracing everyone equally? Shouldn't we relate "migratory flow", "interculturality" and "development" as the ideal for the evolution of a community?

The professionals who work with adolescents and young people (and also it can be extrapolated to community work with adults) are increasingly facing major challenges, among which are: ensuring social cohesion and improving coexistence. **NO MORE BORDERS is a TRAINING COURSE that aims to empower and to provide tools for community intervention, for the social inclusion of newcomers and for the design of intercultural projects.** Youth workers will be able to implement what they have learned during the week in their territories, in their work with community development and artistic development with young people and women (applicable to all genders).



GOALS

- **To acquire tools** in order to improve the community intervention and to develop competences and skills for the effective design of intercultural projects.
- **To incorporate the intercultural perspective** as a model of diversity management in our field.
- **To create a space for exchanging good practices and debates** in the field of community work among youth professionals.
- **To promote the Erasmus+ program at a local level** as a tool for empowering youth professionals, communitarian and international, and as a method to develop intercultural projects.
- **To increase the partner network of TACC** to be able to cooperate closely with associations across Europe.

In order to achieve these objectives, TACC has organized a **training integrated by various activities** -debates, workshops and seminars- which also **promotes the exchange of good practices and the debate around new ways of working with young people in a dynamic, integrating and creative way**. In addition, we will count with the participation of groups that are dedicated to social integration through art and community work from interculturality in the management of diversity.

At the end of the training **we will produce a set of good practices to implement in our territories of origin**, through what we learned during the training week. Finally, **we will develop a creative video** so that other groups join the proposal, multiplying the effect of the project.

In this Training for Trainers, a set of **8 entities of the European Union**, with experience in community intervention projects with newcomers and / or social inclusion projects with vulnerable and / or particularly sensitive groups to the subject matter **will participate**; also these associations have experience in the Erasmus+ Program. **Each partner will participate with 1 youth worker (aged 25 and over)**.



LOGISTICAL ASPECTS

TRAINING COURSE

FROM the 18th to the 22nd of MARCH, 2019
(17th and 23rd as travelling days).

It is allowed to arrive/leave the country **2-3 days** before/after the training course. During the program of the TC we will not visit Barcelona!

The project will take place in the municipality of El Prat de Llobregat, 40min by train from Barcelona-Plaza Catalunya.

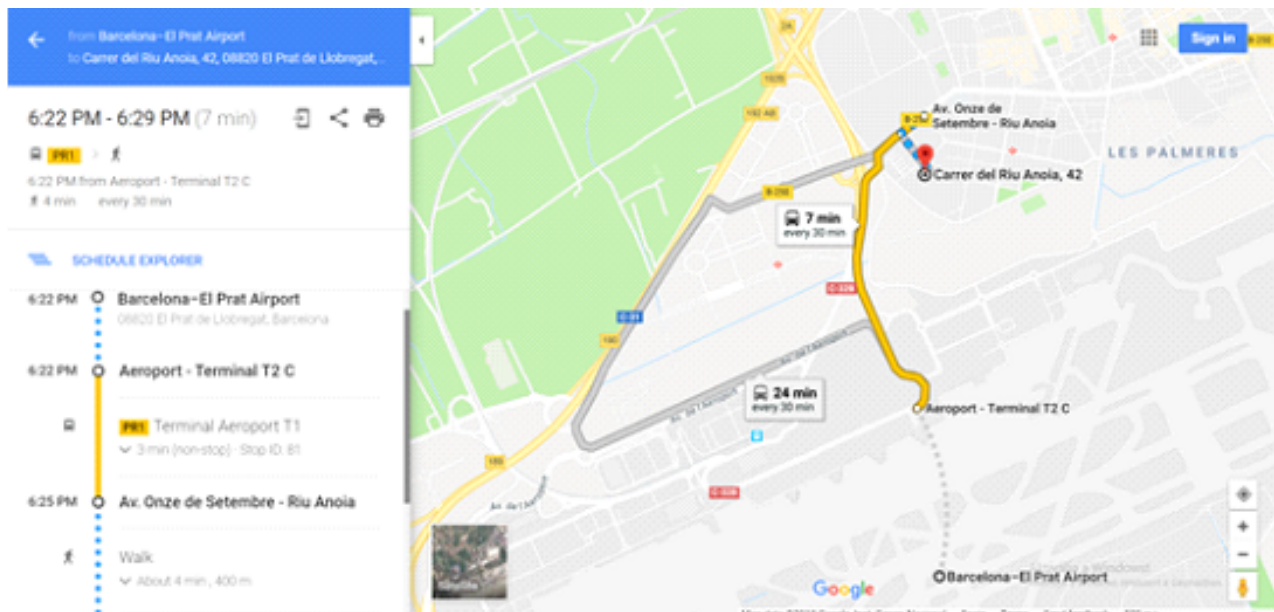


BARCELONA EL PRAT-AIRPORT / THE YOUTH HOSTEL

**From Barcelona - El Prat airport to THE YOUTH HOSTEL
(Address: Carrer del Riu Anoia, 42, 08820 El Prat de Llobregat)**

From Terminal 1 and Terminal 2, there are 2 options to get to the hostel:

- 1 - BUS:** There is a bus that leaves **every 30 minutes**. It is the bus PR1!
Stop called **Avinguda Onze de Setembre – Riu Anoia**.





2 - SUBWAY/METRO: There is the metro **L9 Sud** that leaves **every 10-15 minutes** and it takes 2-3 stops. Stop called **Parc Nou**.



! There is a specific ticket from/to the airport !



Remember to keep all the bills (train/bus/flight) for the reimbursements and the justification of the project. TACC will take everything the first day of the T.C.

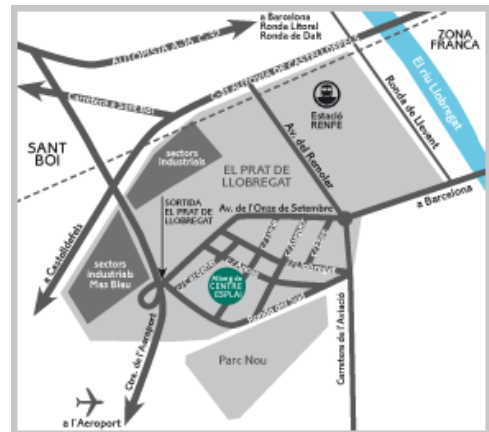

If you want to visit Barcelona before / after the TC:

FROM BARCELONA EL PRAT-AIRPORT TO PLAÇA CATALUNYA

1) From Barcelona - El Prat airport to PLAÇA CATALUNYA

The travel, from the airport to Plaça Catalunya is +/- 30 min.

TRAIN (+or- 6€): From **Barcelona- El Prat, airport** (there are trains with stops in both terminals) to **Plaça Catalunya** square, is **45 min.**

Stop called "**PLAÇA CATALUNYA**".

BUS (6,40€): From **Barcelona- El Prat** to **Plaça Catalunya** directly. **30 min.**

This option is much comfortable and easy in our opinion.
(but up to you, of course).

Stop called "**PLAÇA CATALUNYA**".

2) From Plaça Catalunya to El Prat de Llobregat.

In **Plaça Catalunya** train station (**RENFE**), train number **R3** or **R4** until the stop **Barcelona Sants**.

Then we take the train **R2** or **R2S** of **R2N** until the stop **El Prat de Llobregat**.



BAGGAGE CLAIM

If you would like to see Barcelona before the meeting point, but don't want to carry excessive luggage with you, it is possible to leave it in a baggage claim next to Plaça Catalunya.

- Every youth worker will organize one International Night. For every country, there is a budget up to 30€ to buy food, soft drinks, materials, etc. that will be paid back by giving in valid receipts.
- Due to the correct development of the activities and meetings with other entities, every youth worker is requested to respect timetable and to be on time.
- Smoking inside the living and working places is not allowed.



RULES FOR THE CORRECT DEVELOPMENT OF THE PROJECT

- It is needed to collaborate to keep clean and in order common and private rooms.
- Bringing food and eating inside the living and working places are not allowed.
- The hostel doesn't provide hosts with hygienic products, every youth worker should bring their owns.
